<u>Academics to Practice this Week</u>: Number 0, 1 Shape: Circle Color: Red (Students may earn a sticker for wearing the color of the week.)

**Sharetime**: Children may bring one thing that GOD created to share with the class. Please put share item in your child's cubby, with their name clearly marked.

## Home Enrichment Activities:

- Plan an art activity with your child. Gather crayons, markers, and paper. Have your child draw a picture of what they look like and then tell you about it.
- Sit in front of the mirror with your child. Have him/her tell you what color hair and eyes he has. See if your child can tell you what color hair and eyes you have. Ask your child to point to his/her body parts as you name them. Ex: Ask your child to point to his/her elbow, knee, chin, neck, shoulders, ears, etc.
- Each one of us is so special and deeply loved by God. Read Psalm 139:1-18 and paraphrase it to your child. Say a prayer with your child, thanking God for creating everything and making each person unique, with individual gifts, talents, and characteristics.

<u>Welcome Letter</u>: There is a welcome letter in every student's folder that explains important information that our students participate in throughout the year. The "Welcome Letter" also informs you which day is your child's share day.
