Home Enrichment Activities:

- Using chalk, write capital and lowercase letters A - I on the sidewalk. Then fill a watering can or cup with water and ask your child to identify, then “water” each letter.
- Using a large box or basket, make a “boat” with your child. After reminding your child that the pilgrims came to America in a boat called the Mayflower, have them help you name your boat.
- Make a pilgrim family with your child using toilet paper tubes, black and white construction paper, some markers, and glue. (Hint: Cut the tubes in half to make children.) While the glue is drying, build your pilgrim family a house out of Lincoln Logs (or blocks).
- Have a conversation with your child about when you found out that they were going to be born. Tell them how you felt - excited, happy, and maybe a little nervous? Discuss with them how you got ready for their arrival. Ask your child how they think Mary felt when she found out she was going to have God’s Son. Also, ask them what they think Mary did to get ready for baby Jesus.
