Unit of Study: Community Helpers

Big Idea: Jesus cares for everyone!

Sharetime: Children may bring one item related to community helpers!

Home Enrichment Activities:

- Help your child write a thank you card to a community helper in your area. Have them choose who they want to write to: a doctor, a firefighter, a crossing guard, etc. Then, help your child write a note of thanks and decorate the card with markers, crayons, stickers- anything you have around the house! Take your child with you to deliver it to the community helper.
- Using an ink pad, make fingerprints with your child on a piece of paper. Talk about how God gave each of us different finger prints and how the police use fingerprints to help them find people. See if you and your child can find any fingerprints on anything in your house!
- Act out the story of Zacchaeus with your child! (This story can be found in Luke 19:1-10 if you need a refresher!) Help your child find a tree that is a safe height for them to climb with your assistance. Walk by and ask them to come down, because you're going to their house! After your activity, remind your child that Jesus loved Zacchaeus even though other people didn't like him. (Jesus cares for everyone!) You may also talk about how after Jesus visited with Zacchaeus, Zacchaeus had a changed heart!
