Enrichment Activities:

*On a cloudy day, lay on the grass and look up at the passing clouds. Talk about what each cloud looks like. What do you see – a certain

shape, animals, or object?

*Blow bubbles and see what direction the wind blows them!

*Fly a kite on a day with a nice breeze.

*Talk about different types of clouds: Cirrus clouds are the thin, wispy "feather-like" clouds, cumulus clouds are white puffy clouds that look like floating cotton, and stratus clouds are grayish clouds that often cover the entire sky. They resemble fog that doesn't reach the ground. Learn more
