

- Plant flowers in a pot and help your child learn how to take care of them each day. Growing flowers is a fun way to help your child learn patience and responsibility!
- Read about "Healing the Paralytic" in Mark 2:1-12. Four men wanted to bring their friend who was a paralytic to Jesus so he could be healed. The house Jesus was in was crowded, so the four friends decided to lower the man down from the roof. Jesus not only healed the man, but also forgave his sins!
