## Home Enrichment Activities:

- Create scented and textured paints by adding things such as lemon juice, spices, loose leaf tea, or sand to paint. This is a fun sensory experience for your child!
- Do a blind taste test game with your child. Take turns putting on a blind fold and tasting different kinds of food; use your sense of taste, touch, and smell to help you guess what they are!
- Read about "The Birth of Samuel - God Hears Hannah's Prayer" in 1 Samuel chapter 1. Elkanah and his wife Hannah were not able to have children, and this made Hannah very sad. Hannah asked God for a son and promised to let him be God's servant in the temple if He answered her prayer. God DID answer Hannah's prayers; she gave birth to a son and named him Samuel! When Samuel grew a little older, she brought him to the temple to serve God. Like Hannah, we too can pray to God and know that He hears us!
