**Enrichment Activities:**

- **Have a devotion time with your family.** In Exodus 3, as Moses was shepherding in the land of Midian, he saw a bush that was burning, yet was not consumed. "So Moses said, 'I must turn aside now and see this marvelous sight, why the bush is not burned up.' When the LORD saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush and said, 'Moses, Moses!' And he said, 'Here I am.' Then He said, 'Do not come near here; remove your sandals from your feet, for the place on which you are standing is holy ground'."... (Exodus 3:3-5) There the Lord revealed Himself to Moses as "I AM," the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and showed Moses how He would use him to deliver the Hebrew people from Pharaoh!
- **Have fun counting by fives.** Show your child 20 pennies and 4 nickels. Tell them that 1 nickel is worth 5 pennies. Then group the pennies together by groups of fives and count them by fives (point to each set of five and say "5, 10, 15, 20"). Then count the nickels in the same way (point to each nickel and say "5, 10, 15, 20"). Count more pennies and nickels if you like. ☺
- **Read a fun story together, such as Mickey and His Spaceship,** and notice when this week's sight words (it, on, to) appear by pointing to them and getting excited when you find them!
