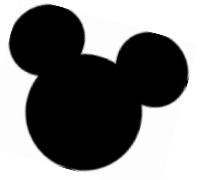

Home Enrichment Activities:

- Go outside with your child at night time and look for the stars up in the sky. Ask your child to find the brightest one. Remind them how the wisemen followed the star to see Jesus.
- Put a wreath up while you are decorating. If you don't want to buy one, you can make one using household items (e.g. construction paper, feathers, plastic ornaments – whatever you have).
- Ask your child to help you tell the story of when Jesus was born on the first Christmas! You can find the story in Luke 2:1-20 of your Bible.
