Unit of Study: Space and Planets

Bible Story: "Moses - Burning Bush"

Enrichment Activities:

- Our Bible verse will be "But, thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ" (First Corinthians 15:57). Please help your child learn this verse during the week as we will also be working on it in class.
- Review our weekly Bible story "Moses - Burning Bush" (Exodus 2:11-25). Moses trusted God and accepted the great challenge that lay before him. We too can do any task, large or small, when God calls us. With His help, we can succeed.
- "Paper Mache Globe" - To make a paper mache globe you will need: a balloon, newspaper, blue and green tissue paper and a mixture of 1-part flour to two parts water. Blow up your balloon; let your child layer on a few layers of newspaper pieces using the flour/water mixture. While the surface is still wet, let your child gently pat on the blue and green tissue paper.
- "Planet" - Cut a big circle out of white construction paper. Find a container or box and place the circle into the box. Take 2 to 3 marbles and 2 different color paints and let your child drop them into the box. Then let your child roll the marbles around the box to create their very own planet!
