## **Home Enrichment Activities:**

- Make binoculars with your child! Save two toilet paper tubes and have your child decorate them with any art supplies you have in the house. Then, glue the tubes together and let it dry. After your binoculars are dry, go to the park to go bird watching!
- Create a bird feeder with your child! Spread peanut butter on a pine cone and roll it in bird seed. Hang it somewhere outside where it will be easy to spot birds as they eat their snack!
- Take your child to a park that has a pond to feed the ducks. You can tear up some bread with your child and throw it to the ducks! After you have run out of bread, ask your child to become a duck with you. Waddle and quack your way around the park!
- Have fun practicing the ABCs in sign language with your child. There is a picture below for reference.
- Help your child practice printing the letter "X" and numbers 10 20. Then, make a yellow oval around each letter and number!
