**Unit of Study:** Woodland, Forest Animals

**Bible Story:** The First Miracle

**Bible Verse:** Phillipians 4:19 "My God shall supply all your need."

**Phonics:** Pig P p The jingle is: P says "p", as in pig. P says, "p, p, p". Blends: pa, pe, pi, po, pu

Zebra Z z The jingle is: Z says "z", as in zebra. Z says, "z, z, z". Blends: za, ze, zi, zo, zu

**Sight Words:** Last week the students brought home their first set of sight words. When they bring home this week's sight words please add them to the ring. By doing this every week your child will be able to practice their sight words often. The sight words for this week are: "the," "to," and "do". We will work on the sounds of these words and see how they are used to form sentences. You can practice with your child at home by pointing these words out in books when you read to your child.

**Share Time:** Students may bring something related to forest animals.

### **Home Enrichment Activities:**

- Make "ants on a log" with your child. Wash a couple of stalks of celery and cut them in half. Then, spread peanut butter (or any other kind of nut butter) on your celery. Then, place raisin "ants" on your celery "log". Enjoy your nutritious snack!
- Talk about what your favorite forest animals are and why.
- Act out different woodland animals: hop like a rabbit, hoot and "fly" like an owl, scamper and frolic like a squirrel, etc.
- Talk with your child about God's presence in his/her life. The Bible says that even though we cannot see God, He is there. Help your child to understand that when he/she prays to God, He hears their prayers. Read Psalm 139 with your child to hear what God says about His presence in our lives.
